## BARLEY GPS TRAIL.

**BARLEY GPS TRAIL 6.25 Km (3.8 Miles) HEIGHT GAIN 250 m (820 feet)**  
**START / FINISH CAR PARK opposite BARLEY VILLAGE HALL SD 82313 40352**  
**GRADE MODERATE**

Enter or download the grid references into your GPS,  
Locate them on the map (OS Explorer OL41) use them as a route or use as GOTOs.

When you get near the locations start looking around for the  
answers to the questions marked in **BLUE** and enjoy a great day out in Bowland.

No GPS - just plot your route on your map using the grid references and off you go.

Remember your GPS will give you a straight line bearing to your destination; you will need  
to refer to your map to ensure you use public rights of way. You do not need to climb any  
walls or gates.
